



ReNew Power spends 1.1 Cr towards COVID relief in Karnataka

- 50 Oxygen Concentrators handed over to Karnataka State Medical Supplies Corporation Limited

Bengaluru, India, June 28, 2021: ReNew Power Private Limited (“ReNew Power” or the “Company”), India’s leading renewable energy company today announced that it has undertaken relief work worth approximate Rs 1.1 Crore towards COVID relief in Karnataka. Representatives from ReNew Power met the Hon’ble CM, Mr. BS Yadiyurappa and briefed him about the various activities undertaken by the company in partnership with various state agencies for COVID relief.

As part of its efforts to work with communities in the state, ReNew Power is donating 50 Oxygen Concentrators of 10 Litre capacity and PPE kits to the Karnataka State Medical Supplies Corporation Limited (KSMCL) for deployment in rural districts of the state immediately. The company will also donate 1 lac PPE kits for supporting the rural healthcare initiatives of the state.

The company will also provision for 10 beds in Bidar and Gadag districts each, and assist the district hospitals at Davangere, Dharwad, Raichur and Yadgir with fully equipped ambulance besides supporting rural hospitals in Belgavi, Dharwad, Ballari, Tumkur, Gadag and Bagalkot with PPE Kits and sanitisers

Speaking about the Initiative, **Ms Vaishali Nigam Sinha, Chief Sustainability Officer, ReNew Power and Chair, ReNew Foundation** said, “ReNew Power is committed to extending its support across the country to fight the pandemic. We are delighted to be a part of state governments efforts to augment and strengthen the healthcare infrastructure in the state and will continue to extend all necessary support to the state administration.”
